The Sunflower competition is about to end—please send in your pictures for September!

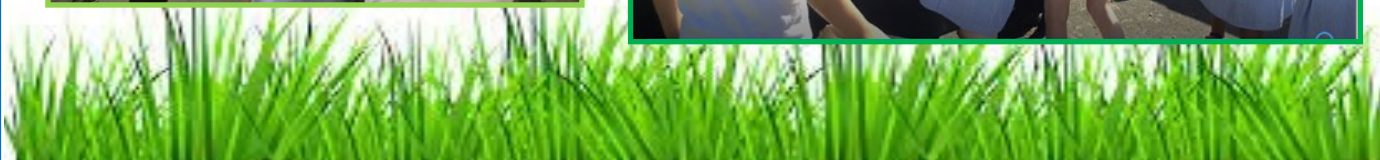
We have had this picture from Liam and can't wait to see how tall all of your sunflower have grown!

SPORTS Day

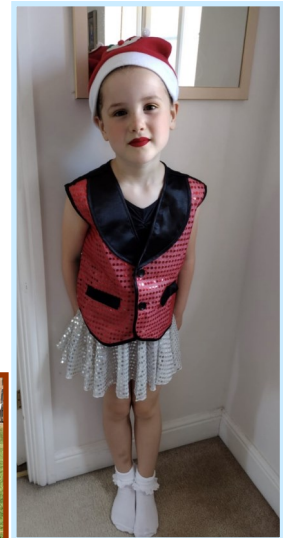
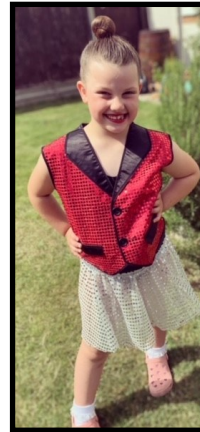
It was so lovely to finally have a Sports Day again post Covid — thank you Miss Smith and Miss Jeffreys for organising such an amazing day for the children!
