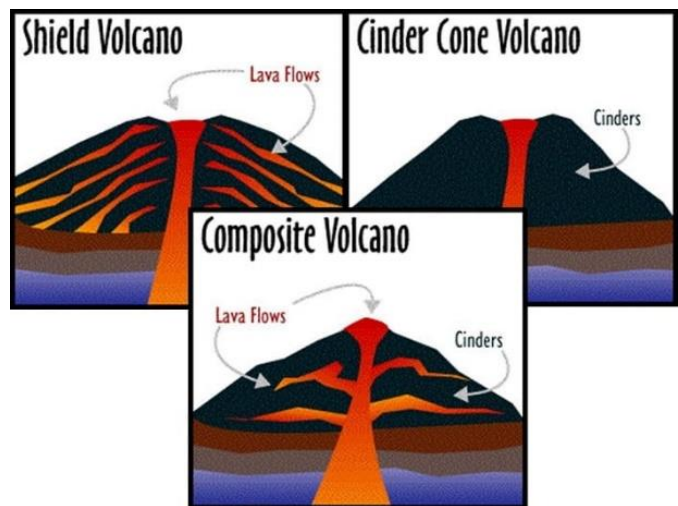


# Geography – Where in the world is Italy and what is it like there?

Key Vocabulary	Definition
continent	A large solid area of land that is usually made up of lots of countries.
peninsula	An area of land surrounded by water on three sides.
physical geography	The natural features of a country or area.
human geography	Where people live, what they do and how they use the land.
volcanoes	An opening in the surface of the Earth that allows lava, ash and hot gases to escape.
eruption	An explosion of steam and lava from a volcano.
active	A volcano that has recently erupted or is likely to erupt soon.
dormant	A volcano that has not erupted in a long time but may erupt again in the future.
extinct	A volcano that no longer has a supply of magma and will not erupt again.
