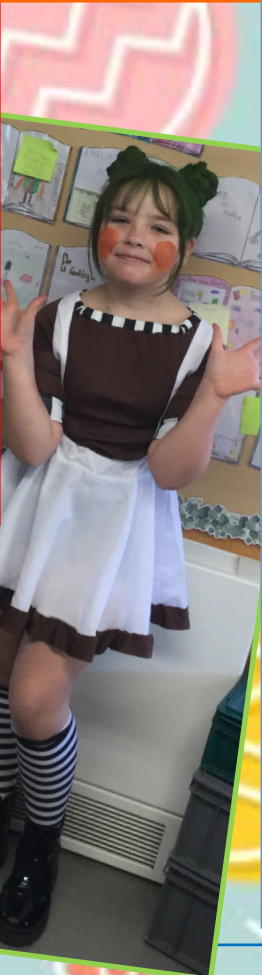
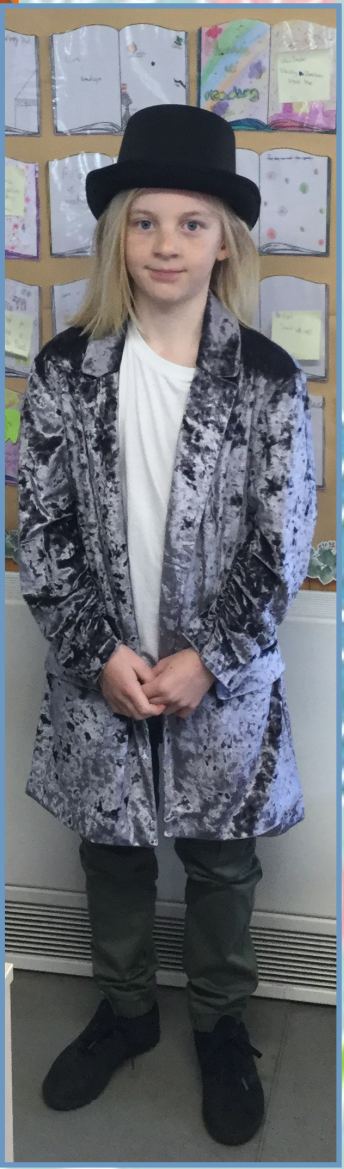
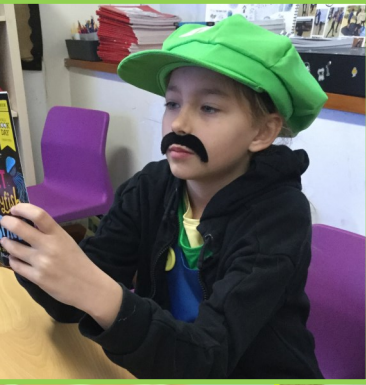
I hope everyone has a wonderful and very well deserved rest over the Easter holidays, with lots of fun and Easter egg hunts!

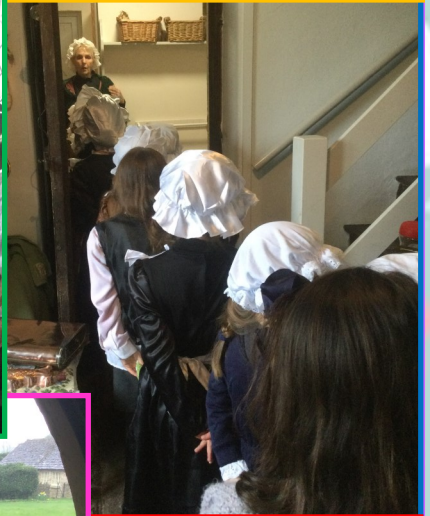
World Book Day 2024

He reviewed 'How To Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell and his review won him a stuffed Toothless toy and this lovely comment!

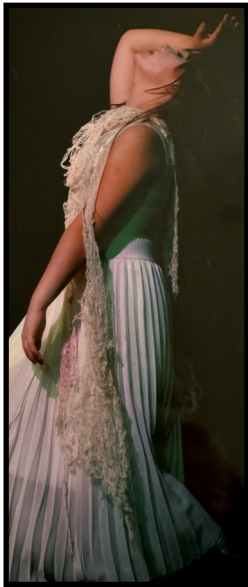
Well done, we are super proud of you.

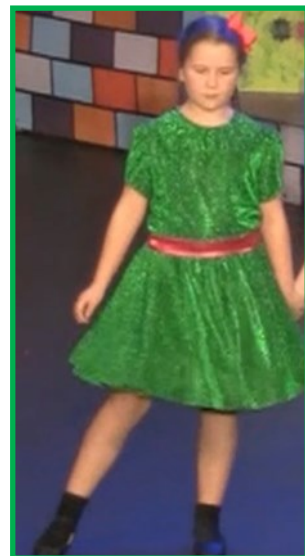
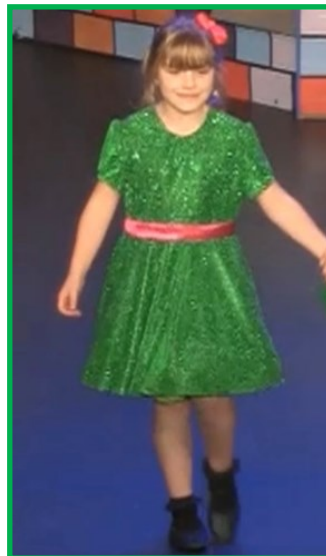
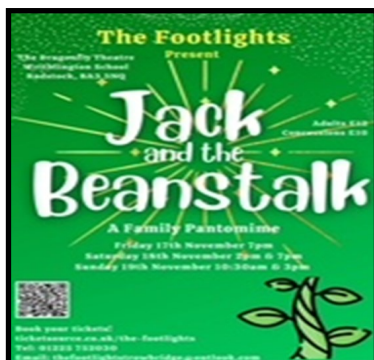
Student Spotlight
